

## Table 2. Clinical manifestations of TTP-HUS

<b>System</b>	<b>Manifestations</b>
<b>Constitutional</b>	Fever, fatigue
<b>Hematologic</b>	Petechiae, ecchymoses, purpura, hematuria, bleeding
<b>Neurologic</b>	Major: seizure, stroke, coma Minor: confusion, agitation, headache
<b>Renal</b>	Azotemia, proteinuria, hematuria, hemosiderinuria, acute renal failure
<b>Gastrointestinal</b>	Abdominal pain, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, jaundice, hepatosplenomegaly
<b>Cardiovascular/ pulmonary</b>	Cough, dyspnea, chest pain, ARDS
<b>Other</b>	Arthralgias, diabetes insipidus
